# Coppelia Synopsis

### **PRELUDE**

# Village Square

Every morning Dr. Coppelius and his quiet, book-toting daughter Coppelia take a morning stroll. Frantz, a shy young man with a penchant for reading, is interested in the mysterious Coppélia. He would like to get to know her because of their shared interest in books. The problem is that Dr. Coppelius only takes her out in the morning, forbidding her from interacting with any of the village community members. Frantz decides to leave a book for her in hopes of engaging her interests.

#### ACT 1 - Scene 1

The village is preparing for the Spring Bell Festival the next day. The festival, led by the Mayor, celebrates the return of spring with the gift of a bell handed from one young person to the next. This year's honor has been bestowed upon Frantz who must select the next person before the festivities in the morning. According to his friends; smart, beautiful and outspoken Swanhilda would be the perfect counterpart for Frantz. If only they can find some common ground. Dr. Coppelius makes a surprising midday appearance in town and the village children are fascinated by him. His temper flares and Dr. Coppelius shoos the children away. Swanhilda is offended by Coppelius' behavior and when the key to his workshop is discovered by her friends they decide to sneak in and investigate the mysterious workshop of Dr. Coppelius. Frantz must know before the morning if his gift to Coppélia has been warmly received. He decides to enter and meet her.

#### Scene 2

# Inside Dr Coppelius' workshop that evening

Swanilda and her friends search for the girl they see with Dr. Coppelius. Much to their amusement, inside they find mechanical dolls. Dr. Coppelius' daughter is a Doll! Dr. Coppelius returns home and in finding the girls he chases them out - except for Swanilda who hides. Dr. Coppelius, exhausted from the ruckus, sits for a rest just as Frantz enters. When Dr. Coppelius sees Frantz, he attempts magic in order to take Frantz's spirit and transfer it to Coppélia thus turning her into the real, live daughter he has always wished for. Dr. Coppelius is tricked by Swanilda and thinks his magic worked. His daughter is alive! In the ensuing madness Swanilda and Frantz escape leaving Dr. Coppelius broken-hearted.

The Festival of the Bells and the celebration of Spring has finally arrived. The next morning the Mayor inspects the village square.
